Step 1

Autocrats <u>want</u> to be called liars. That's why Autocrats double down on lies, even when proven untrue.

This ensures the question of "who's the liar" and disputes over simple facts stay unresolved.

Step 2

Without agreement on the facts, voters distrust politics and the establishment. They either disengage or have little choice but to vote on personality and promises.

If the autocrat wins the election...

Step 3

...They can now claim a mandate to replace the judges, journalists and public servants they accused of dishonesty.


